

SECURITY PROTOCOLS

Angel Flight Central is dedicated to the ongoing safety and security of its passengers and volunteer pilots. With the FAA's focused attention on General Aviation security measures, the procedures contained herein are designed to protect the volunteer pilots and passengers involved directly or indirectly with all Angel Flight Central flights. Angel Flight Central relies on volunteer pilots to use their best judgment regarding these matters.

- Angel Flight Central volunteer pilots are authorized to check all adult passenger IDs to ensure the names match those listed on the flight Itinerary.
- If requested, adult passengers are required to present the AFC pilot with their government-issued photo IDs *prior* to boarding the aircraft.
- Forms of ID accepted include a Federal Government ID card, Military ID,
 Driver's License, Passport or any other Federal or State issued photo ID.
- Baggage is subject to search by the pilot at the pilot's discretion.

• The pilot may refuse to transport any baggage that is over the weight limit or any additional items not disclosed during screening by the passenger.

- Angel Flight Central prohibits the concealment, or carry on, of any weapon, including a firearm by any passenger on the aircraft.
- Volunteer Pilots reserve the right not to fly passengers who appear to be under the influence of alcohol and/or recreational drugs, who cannot or refuse to comply with the Pilot's instructions or whose behavior is deemed to interfere with the safety of the flight (see Far, Part 91.17(b)).
